I offered to give the lesson to the students and faculty of Columbia U. by sending an email to the University Minister who supervises about a dozen campus ministers for the various religions. Instead of declining in writing, I got a telephone call from the Department of Public Safety telling me not to contact anyone at Columbia U. about my offer. This verbal order was repeated in a meeting on the campus that I requested. My response was to send an email of complaint to the President of Columbia (Lee Bollinger) with a copy mailed to the General Council (Jane Booth). I then got a letter from Ms. Booth threatening me with legal action if I contacted anyone at Columbia. I filed an ethics complaint against Ms. Booth for conspiring maliciously to violate the academic freedom of the students and faculty at Columbia with the New York State Unified Court System.
